1. Minutes

- A. The minutes of the August meeting were approved.

2. Treasury Report

- A. Mr. Milligan handed out a copy of the treasurer's report. Everyone is paid up to date..
- B. Compared to last year at this time we are about \$250 behind. So we are real close to last years totals.

3. Soccer

- A. This years Season will begin on Sat. Sept. 15th.
- B. Sat. Games will again be at Friendly Park, at SW 22nd and Shartel. Sun. Games will be again at Overholser fields. The only exception will be Sept 16th and Oct 14. those Sundays they will be played at legends sports complex at 122nd and Western. **(Tell your parents there will be no coolers allowed at Legends)**

C. The fees this year has changed a little. They are as follows

Kindergarten	\$65	will play 3 vs. 3 and use a #3 ball.
Div. 1 (1 st and 2 nd)	\$150	will play 7 vs. 7 and use a #4 ball. (Goalie included)
Div. 2 (3 rd and 4 th)	\$150	will play 9 vs. 9 and use a #4 ball.
Div. 3 (5 th and 6 th)	\$150	will play 9 vs. 9 and use a # 4 ball.
7 th and 8 th grade	\$100	will play 9 vs. 9 (unless both coaches agree to 11 vs. 11) and use a #4 ball.

D. Rules were handed out at the meeting.

E. Teams are Co-ed and will play as recreational.

F The first weeks schedules will be faxed on Monday the 10th.

G. If you have not paid your soccer fee's do so by next meeting.

4. Volleyball

Mr. Cooper addressed the meeting about the upcoming Volleyball Season.

A. Games will begin the weekend of Sept 15th

B. Gym coordinators need to have a good game ball for each game day.

6. Track

7. Rosters

All the all school rosters were due at the Sept. Meeting. I did not receive any from All Saints, St. Johns Episcopal, St. Johns Yukon, St. Mary's, Villa Teresa. I did receive one that did not have the name of the school on it, if it belongs to you let me know.

If you decide not to due the all school roster, your sports rosters for volleyball and soccer are due at the Oct meeting.

Schools that have not submitted their team rosters by the Oct. Meeting will become ineligible for medals and trophies. No Exceptions!!!!!!

A. All School Rosters

The all school roster provides schools with a means to provide the CGSAA with student birth date information for all sports at once. The all school roster is not mandatory but is recommended.

The All school roster is organized according to grade and consists of the birth date for each student in the school. The Principal's signature, vouching for birth date accuracy, is required; it is the responsibility of the CGSAA rep. To review all birth dates to identify unreasonable dates and ineligible students.

The all school rosters are to be given to the CGSAA secretary, Brad Segard, at the September Meeting.

B. Sports Roster

Each sport roster shall be submitted to the appropriate sport commissioner on 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper and shall consist of only those students on the team (do Not submit school rosters with non-participating students lined out),

1. With an all school roster

Volleyball, soccer, and basketball require sport rosters even though an All School roster has been submitted, In this case, the sport rosters only list the name and grade of each student participating on each team. No signatures are required: No roster is required for the track meet.

2. With no all school roster

Volleyball, soccer, basketball, and track require sport rosters. In this case, the sports rosters list the name, grade, and birth date of each student participating on each team. The Principal's signature is required; it is the responsibility of the CGSAA rep. To review all birth dates to identify unreasonable dates and ineligible students.

8. New Business

- A. After I sent out the new directory I had several people decide to give me updated information. To I will send an updated directory asap
- B. Mr. Glover addressed the meeting stating the importance of having each schools rep or alternate rep at every meeting.
- C. If coaches or parents have a problem they must go through you as a rep. Do not write your Parish or Priest because it will come right back to our group anyway to take care of.

D. Make sure you let your parents know that they need to control themselves at each sporting event. More problems are caused by parents than our athletes.
