### 1. Minutes

- A. The minutes of the Jan. meeting were approved with the exception of the section under Basketball, Section 5, part E, Number 3. It should say ...approval or denial by a Majority vote....

### 2. Treasury Report

- A. Mr. Milligan handed out a copy of the treasurer's report. Everyone is paid up, up to this point.
- B. Please remember that scorebook keepers, clock operators, and gatekeepers will be paid \$5.25 per game. If they decline the money please keep it for your athletic fund.
- C. Please send Mr. Milligan a check for \$40 per team you are entering into the tournaments.
- D. At this time we are approximately \$6300 ahead of last year at this time.

**3. Soccer**

- A. Mr. Tiarks brought a copy of the contract, in which we voted to accept, for using the YWCA soccer fields next year.
- B. The YWCA is located at 6103 NW 58 st. Go to NW 58<sup>th</sup> and Macarthur, turn west and go approximately 6 blocks.
- C. On Saturday we will still use Friendly Park, On Sunday's we will use the YWCA.

**4. Volleyball**

- A. Mr. Cooper was not present to address the meeting.

**5. Basketball**

Mr. Hotte addressed the meeting about this years Basketball season.

- A. The 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade tournament will be Feb. 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, and 16<sup>th</sup>.
- B. The Brackets or on the web site.
- C. The 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade tournament will be Feb 28, Mar 1, and 2.
- D. Villa Teresa called Mr. Hotte and explained that they have a girl on their team that is not going to their school anymore. The Principal overlooked this when she signed the all school rosters. We will discuss in executive meeting a penalty.
- E. St. Elizabeth brought up that they would have 7 boys from their 7<sup>th</sup> grade boy's team taking the Duke test at the same time they are scheduled to play Trinity on Feb. 8<sup>th</sup>. They were asking to reschedule the game. Mr. Hotte explained that they have never rescheduled games before and that they should have told him at the Oct. meeting to try to schedule around that time. We told him we would bring it up in the executive meeting and let him know.
- F. There was a discussion about the officials at the meeting. It seems that there have been more complaints this year about the officials and making bad calls or not knowing the rules. For specific problems Mr. Savely said he would check into them. If an official seems to not know the CGSAA rule on something check with the gym coordinator.

**6. Track**

Mr. Kelly was present to discuss the track meet.

- A. The track meet is still set for April 26.
- B. Practices will not start until after spring break.
- C. Your team will not be allowed to practice unless your school has a representative attend a meeting that the McGuiness track coach will have to explain practice rules.

## 8. Executive Committee

A. The Executive Committee met to discuss the situation with the Christ the King 5<sup>th</sup> grade boys.

The Background is at the Jan. executive meeting the 5<sup>th</sup> grade boys from Christ the King were advised to separate the roster into two separate teams, and no player was so play on more than one team. Christ the Kings 5<sup>th</sup> grade teams violated this express provision.

On the Weekend of Jan. 25 and 26<sup>th</sup>, these two teams had games back to back in the same gym. That weekend 8 of the 15 boys from the two teams had a Boy Scout camp to go to. This left 7 boys, from both rosters, left to play.

The coaches came to the first game with the 7 players and began playing the game. At half time the opposing coach confronted the Christ the King Coach saying that these were not the same players they had the last time they had played. At that time the Christ the King Coach acknowledged that they were not and that this was going to be a forfeit, but wanted to let the kids play the game anyway since it was on the schedule. When they began the second game and had the same players from the first game the opposing coach of the second game asked the Christ the King Coach, and he had the same response.

Because of the previous rules infraction and the decision of the executive committee at the January meeting, both coaches for the Christ the King 5<sup>th</sup> grade boys team were suspended for the league games on the weekend of Feb 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> and until the next executive committee meeting could be held after the February CGSAA league meeting to determine if further penalties would be assessed.

Mr. Morrissey, the representative for Christ the King, requested an opportunity to again address the committee regarding this most recent issue. He stated that he was told about the campout prior to the season, but failed to make a note of it and forgot to let Mr. Hotte know so that he would not schedule games for that day. His coaches on the other hand thought that the league knew of this situation and felt that they could combine the remaining players to play the games but that they would automatically be forfeits.

Mr. Morrissey apologized for not making it clear to the coaches that they were under no circumstances to continue to combine players for the remainder of the regular season, and for also not having that weekend cleared of games.

Mr. Morrissey asked that the coaches, players, and parents not be penalized for his mistakes.

The Executive Committee met for over an hour to discuss what should be done. The items under consideration were whether or not to let the coaches finish coaching the remainder of the season, whether or not to let the players that played with the combined teams to be able to play any more this year, and whether or not to let either team, or a combined team, play in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade tournament.

The first motion for penalty was to not let the team(s) play at all in the tournament. This motion failed with a 3-3 tie vote.

The second motion for penalty was to let the teams play as two teams with the current league rosters but not let the coaches continue to coach the remainder of the season and/or the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade tournament. This motion also failed with a 2-4 vote.

The Third motion for penalty was to let the players play as one team in the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade tournament; however they would play two games maximum. Both games would be administrative forfeits. No matter if they won or lost the first game they will move to the loser's bracket, no matter if they win or lose the second game they will be out of the tournament and the other team moves on. In the event that the team fails to show up for the game(s) they will not be able to have a team for the 6<sup>th</sup>

grade boys next year. The coach's suspension would be lifted and will be able to coach the last weekend and the tournament.

**B.** The St. Elizabeth team that wanted to reschedule was denied and will either have to play or forfeit.

**C.** Villa Teresa will have to forfeit all the games that the illegal player played in. The coach will be suspended for one game. And the illegal player cannot play in any other games.

**D.** There were 4 teams that forfeited games last weekend due to illness. All teams contacted Mr. Hotte in plenty of time before their games so no fees were assessed.
