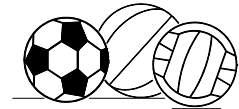

2. The minutes of the May Meeting were approved

3. Treasurers Report

A. A copy of the treasurer's report was available. Several schools still owe fines from last year's basketball season and two schools owe a portion of the annual fee. These fees must be paid in full for your school to participate in the league.

B. The treasurer's report was approved and accepted.

4. Soccer

A. Soccer games will begin on September 17 and be played at the IONE Branch of the YMCA. The season will last through the weekend of November 1.

B. The number of teams, any exception dates, and the number of children wanting to play but without a team are due at the next meeting, September 7.

C. The fee for soccer will be: Kindergarten - \$65, Grades 1-5 - \$170, Grades 7 & 8 - \$140

5. Volleyball

- A. Volleyball games will begin on Sept. 17 and continue through October 30.
- B. All forms handed out at the August meeting must be returned to Matt by the next meeting on Sept. 7. He will be out of town and unavailable as he schedules teams over the weekend of September 10.
- C. The fee for volleyball is \$210 per team.
- D. Please make note of the changes in the rules. Changes for 5th and 6th grade teams are in the rules numbered 9, 26, 28 and 30. Changes for 7th and 8th are in the rules numbered 9, 30 and 32.

6. Basketball

- A. As the gym coordinators check for exception dates on gym usage for the volleyball season, also check for the exception dates that will occur during basketball season.

7. Track

- A. There was no track report given.

9. New Business

- A. Sacred Heart school sent a thank you letter to the CGSAA for our donation to help refinish their gym floor.

B. Once again the participation rule in basketball will be discussed prior to the beginning of the season. Make sure you know how your principal feels about this issue.

C. All school rosters are due at the Sept. meeting. Schools that have not submitted their team rosters by the October meeting will become ineligible for medals and trophies.

10. All School Rosters

A. The all school roster provides schools with a means to provide the CGSAA with student birth date information for all sports at once. The all school roster is not mandatory but is recommended.

B. The all school roster is organized according to grade and consists of the birth date for each student in the school. The Principal's signature, vouching for birth date accuracy, is required; it is the responsibility of the CGSAA rep. to review all birth dates to identify unreasonable dates and ineligible students.

11. Sports Rosters

A. Each sport roster shall be submitted to the appropriate sport commissioner and shall consist of only those students on the team (do not submit school rosters with non-participation students lined out).

B. If you have submitted an all school roster, sport rosters only list the name and grade of each student participating on each team. No principal's signature is required. If you have not submitted an all school roster, the sports roster should list the name, grade and birth date of each student participating on each team. The principal's signature is required on this form.

- c) 2nd 9-1-96
- d) 3rd 9-1-95
- e) 4th 9-1-94
- f) 5th 9-1-93
- g) 6th 9-1-92
- h) 7th 9-1-91
- i) 8th 9-1-90
