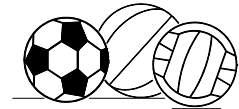

2. The minutes of the August meeting were approved.

3. Treasurers Report

A. A copy of the treasurer's report was available. The following schools still owe fines from either last year's basketball season or from the annual meeting fee. These fees must be paid in full for your school to participate in the league.

4. Soccer

A. Soccer games will begin on September 17 and be played at the IONE Branch of the YMCA. The season will last through the weekend of November 1.

5. Volleyball

A. Volleyball games will begin on Sept. 17 and continue through October 30.

B. The schedule of league games will be available on the website on Tuesday, Sept. 13. Only the games for the first weekend, Sept. 17 & 18, will be valid. Check for any inconsistencies in your schedule and let Matt know next week. The final schedule for the remaining weekends will be on the website by Tuesday, Sept 20.

C. The fee for volleyball is \$210 per team.

D. Please make note of the changes in the rules. Changes for 5th and 6th grade teams are in the rules numbered 9, 26, 28 and 30. Changes for 7th and 8th are in the rules numbered 9, 30 and 32.
