1. Minutes

The minutes of the September meeting were approved.

2. Treasurers Report

A copy of the treasurer's report was handed out. St. John's Episcopal still owes an attendance fee of \$25 from last year.

3. Unfinished Business

The 6th grade basketball teams will follow the participation rules that are set for the 4th and 5th grade teams. All sixth graders must play in a full, designated quarter during each game. The designations are to be made at the beginning of the games.

Starting in January, 2007, the CGSAA monthly meetings will be held in the commons area of Bishop McGuinness High School. You will need to enter through the main entrance on Lee Street. There is some parking in front of the building with additional parking in the lot.

There is a parent from Rosary School who will not be able to attend any games of the CGSAA. Rosary parents and coaches will help to make sure this parent is not attending any the games this year.

Flyers and a press bulletin about the upcoming speaker, Dr. Len DiPaul, were handed out to the school representatives. Make sure these are distributed to all coaches and put in the church bulletins. The CGSAA mandatory coaches meeting will be held at Bishop McGuinness after Dr. DiPaul speaks on Sunday, November 12.

3. Soccer

The parking at the soccer fields is still a problem. There is plenty of parking beyond the YWCA building. Have patience.

4. Volleyball

All fifth graders that are playing in the sixth grade league will follow the sixth grade rules.

5. Basketball

Please fax all game exception dates to Barry before October 20. The number of teams from your school may be changed until October 20. After that date, fines will be assessed for any changes in the number of teams from your school.

The "data form" sheet, "request for transfers" form and "request for scheduling considerations" form (all signed by your principal) need to be given to Barry at the November meeting.

The team rosters and the basketball coaches' information sheet need to be turned in at the December meeting.

The fee has gone up to \$340 per team. Basketball fees will be due at the November meeting.

Let Barry know if your sixth grade teams will be entering the Yukon tournament so that he can block out that date for your teams. The information and registration for the tournament are on our website.

The Turkey Tournament is also on the website. Registration for the Turkey Tournament can only be done through the web.

The updated rules for basketball are on the website. Please make sure that copies of the rules are given to each coach. After reading the rules each coach needs to sign the rules sheet. This sheet is also due at the December meeting.

The mandatory coaches meeting will be on Sunday, November 12 at Bishop McGuinness. The coaches meeting will follow the speaker, Len DiPaul, who will begin his workshop at 1:00 pm in the McGuinness auditorium.
