### 1. Minutes

The minutes of the October meeting were approved.

### 2. Treasurers Report

A copy of the treasurer's report was handed out. St. John's Episcopal still owes an attendance fee of \$25 from last year.

All Saints paid the wrong amount for their volleyball team. They owe \$10.00 for volleyball fees.

St. Charles owes \$40.00 for soccer fees.

Mike will send money to each school for the referees, gym rental and scoreboard keeper for the basketball games. He will send this money one month at a time.

### 3. Unfinished Business

Schools can decide whether or not to send their teams to tournaments outside the CGSAA as long as that tournament does not conflict with regular league games. The sixth grade teams need to start all their games on the first weekend in December to allow enough weekends to complete their schedule. One weekend is set aside for the St. John's Yukon 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Tournament.

There was a request made by a CGSAA school to allow a young seventh grader to play on a sixth grade team. The executive committee discussed the exception, and it was decided to not allow the student to play down a grade level. It has not been allowed in the past, and it would set a precedent that does not follow the league bylaws.

Advise coaches and parents to bring complaints or concerns to their school representatives first. The reps will take the concern to the executive committee if the matter can not be settled at the school.

Please plan to attend Dr. Len DiPaul's workshop on November 12 at Bishop McGuinness High School. He will speak to coaches, administrators and parents about the role of sports in church and society. He is the executive director for the Department of Pastoral and Theological Studies at Neumann College and serves as Chairperson of the Advisory Board for the National Center for Catholic Youth Sports. Dr. DiPaul has presented countless addresses throughout the country and we are lucky to have him come to Oklahoma. He will be leading the workshop from 1:00 pm until 3:00 pm on Sunday, November 12, in the commons area of Bishop McGuinness High School.

The mandatory basketball coaches' meeting will follow Dr. DiPaul's workshop. The meeting will be held in the McGuinness gym and be from 3:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m.

### 3. Soccer
