1. Minutes

The minutes of the February meeting were approved.

2. Treasurers Report

A copy of the treasurer’s report was handed out. St. John’s Episcopal still owes an attendance fee of \$25 from last year and a soccer fee of \$140. Trinity owes a basketball fee of \$340.

There was discussion about the games that were not played due to weather, and what should become of the fees already collected for those games. It was decided to return the fees to the schools.

3. Unfinished Business

There was a long discussion about the poor behavior of several fans during the state tournament. If a fan is ejected from the gym, he/she may not come to the next game. This rule will carry over into the 2007-08 season. Let Barry know if there was a fan ejected from your gym during the state tournament, or if the game was stopped because of fan behavior.

Barry will let the school representative know if there are any parents who will not be able to attend the first game of the season next year.

In the future, coaches will be asked by the referees to control the fans from their school. If the fans do not stop the unacceptable behavior, the coach will be given a technical foul. This information will be told to the coaches at the coaches meeting and will be included in the CGSAA basketball rules.

6. Basketball

Despite the behavior of some fans, the C.K. Glover Tournament was a wonderful event. Thank you to all the gym coordinators, official's commissioner and everyone who helped make the tournament a success. Next year Barry will write one set of rules that will apply to both league play and tournament play. All the tournament rules will be discussed again at the February meeting to make sure that they are understood by all the representatives.

7. Track

The track meet will be held on April 21st. There is an amended event schedule and practice schedule on the website. Please check your practice times and the event schedule.

It is very important that the correct shoes be worn by all track participants. Only tennis shoes or running shoes are allowed on the new surface. No spikes of any kind are allowed on the track. If a child is wearing the wrong shoe he/she will be out of the track meet for the rest of the day.

Make sure you have enough adults to help at the practices at McGuinness to keep the McGuinness facility in good shape. All shoes should be checked before letting the students run on the track. Only shoes without spikes are allowed. If your school will not be using a practice time, let Jerry know so that he can give that time to another school.

Let parents know that parking will be a problem during the meet this year because of the construction going on at McGuinness. Jerry is trying to find out if fans will be able to park in the Shartel Shopping parking lots.

The fee of \$150 per school or \$9.00 per child is due at the April meeting.

All participants at the McGuinness meet need to have their name, grade and event clearly written on a name tag.

8. New Business

It was unanimously approved to give Trinity School money to help pay for some of the cost of getting a working scoreboard.
