1. Minutes

4. Soccer

Please do not park on N.W. 58th Street outside the soccer fields.

There is construction on MacArthur which will make it difficult to enter the park from MacArthur. Hank has suggested that everyone travel on Grove and cross MacArthur on 58th Street.

Remember that no player will be eligible to play on more than one team in a league play. Hank and Matt will try to work out a schedule that will allow kids to play both soccer and volleyball.

We will also vote to change the rule about designating players. The new rule will state that coaches fill in all the players in their designated quarters at the beginning of the game.

The Turkey Tournament will be held on November 16 – 19 and November 24-26. All application forms are on line. The application dead line is November 10.
