4. Soccer

5. Volleyball

All sixth grade girls' games that are scheduled at Sacred Heart over the 25 and 26 of October will be moved to Christ the King gym.

Bishop McGuinness will host their annual Shamrock tournament at the end of our season. There is a flyer attached with these minutes.

6. Basketball

The number of teams from each school was given to Barry at the meeting. Your school has until October 17 to make any changes. After that date, fines will be assessed for any changes in the number of teams from your school.

The "data form" sheet, "request for transfers" form and "request for scheduling considerations" form (all signed by your principal) need to be given to Barry at the November meeting.

The team rosters and the basketball coaches' information sheet need to be turned in at the December meeting.

The fee has gone up to \$375 per team. Basketball fees will be due at the November meeting.

Information about the Turkey Tournament will be on the website.

The Tulsa Tournament will be the first weekend in December. Only 7th and 8th grade teams may enter. All other grades will be starting the season with league games that weekend.

Please remind your coaches that they need to clear the bench as soon as possible so that the team playing next will have enough time to warm up. It would be a good idea to have the teams stretch in the lobby or another location before their 5 minute pre-game time on the court.

After the rules are set and posted on the website, please make sure that copies of the rules are given to each coach and made available to all families who will have children playing on a basketball team. After reading the rules each coach needs to sign the rules sheet. This sheet is due at the December meeting.

There will be a mandatory coaches meeting this year. The date will be announced at the November meeting.

Bishop McGuinness will host a basketball bonanza day for 7th and 8th grade girls' coaches and players. There will be speakers, games and lunch. The tentative date is November 15.
