Reminders about the upcoming tournaments:

The rules are posted on the website. The only changes from the league rules are:

Remember that every player in the 4th grade tournament will get a medal when they leave the gym after their last game. The brackets will be on the website.

The participation rule will be in effect for the 4th and 5th grade tournament. Please bring the official scorebooks to the March meeting.

Only players and coaches (three maximum) will be allowed on the bench.

The entrance fee at the gate will be \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for high school students and seniors.

Coaches for the 4th and 5th grade tournaments will sign in at the gym and coaches for the 6th, 7th and 8th grade tournament will receive passes. The passes for 6th, 7th and 8th were passed out at the meeting. Please email Barry if you need extra passes for principals, teachers or priests at your school.

If a child is wearing the wrong shoes he/she will be out of the track meet for the rest of the day.

A motion was made and passed to amend some of the events at our track meet to match the events at the Hershey meet. As a result more students might be able to qualify for a Hershey meet.
