1. Minutes

2. Treasurers Report

7. Track

The track meet will be held on April 25. The rules, practice schedules, school responsibilities and schedule of events are posted on the website. The current rules are under the track symbol at the top of the web page.

The tug-of-war will start at 12:30 p.m.. It is not counted as a field event and will not have a point value. There will be eight person teams with two children (a boy and a girl) from each grade, five through eight.

Dave Dunlevy would like to have several doctors available at the track meet. Please contact Dave if you know of any doctor who will be attending the meet to watch his/her child participate.

If you have equipment that you used at the meet last year (i.e. rakes for the long jump) please bring it to the track meet even if your school is not responsible for that event this year.

If your school is having trouble finding volunteers to work at the track meet, consider asking high school student who need community service hours.

This year there will be a trophy for the school that gets the most points in the morning (grades 1 through 4) and a trophy for the winning school in the afternoon (grades 5 through 8).
