Notes for Gym Coordinators:

Please fax the score sheets to Barry every Monday. He will update the website with the wins and loses each week.

Ask clock keepers to stay off cell phones and ipods during the games.

You might consider having a set of target jerseys at your gym for teams that are wearing the same color.

It would be wise to have a stop watch at your gym in the event that the clock goes out.

Notes for coaches:

Check the website each week to make sure that there are no changes in the schedule and that your win/lose record is correct. Also check the website for games being cancelled due to weather.

The participation rule is not monitored by the referees. If you feel that there has been a violation, you need to let the gym coordinator know. The CGSAA will enforce the consequences for not following the designated quarter rule.

Some of the referees might not know the rules at the beginning of the season. Go along with their calls and let your rep know about the discrepancies.

If you or a parent have a problem with the referees please call your school representative, do not approach the referee or the coach of the opposing team.

When the "no press rule" is being enforced any defense in the back court will be a violation. The ball needs to get to the half court. Fouls will not be called unless they occur on a rebound.

Wrist bands or head bands need to be white, beige, black or the team color. All players need to have the same color.

Sacred Heart will not be hosting the Turkey Tournament next year. St. James will do it again with help from another school.
