Reminders about the upcoming tournaments:

Gym coordinators make sure to be at your gyms early, especially if there is a Tulsa team playing first. Teams should not warm up on the court unless both teams are there, or if it is ten minutes before game time.

The rules are posted on the website. The only changes from the league rules are:

There is no participation rule for the sixth grade during the tournament.

Game time is forfeit time. There is no ten minute grace period as there is during the season.

Remember that every player in the 4th grade tournament will get a medal when they leave the gym after their last game. The brackets will be on the website.

The participation rule will be in effect for the 4th and 5th grade tournament. Please bring the official scorebooks to the March meeting.

Only players and coaches (three maximum) will be allowed on the bench.

The entrance fee at the gate will be \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for high school students and seniors.

Coaches for the 4th and 5th grade tournaments will sign in at the gym and coaches for the 6th, 7th and 8th grade tournament will receive passes. Barry will get the passes to the schools before the tournament begins on February 25. Please email Barry if you need extra passes for principals, teachers or priests at your school.

Have your coaches check the website to make sure their team's win/loss record is correct. Let Barry know if there are any errors. He will use the website to set the brackets for the 5th through 8th grade teams.

7. Track

The track meet will be held on April 17. Each school needs to send Dave the email address or phone number of their track coordinator. He also needs to know if your school will be participating in the track meet and/or if your school will not need practice time at McGuinness.

As soon as they are finalized, the rules, practice schedules, school responsibilities and schedule of events will be posted on the website. The shot put and discus will possibly begin at 10:30 a.m. There is also a possibility that the results will go into the computer and the ribbons will be distributed later in the week. This will eliminate the need for parents in the press box. Dave will need names of all the students that will be participating in the meet.

Make sure that you have extra parents to cover the responsibilities on the track that day. Dave would like the names of the parents who are scheduled to help that day.

It is very important that the correct shoes be worn by all track participants. Only tennis shoes or running shoes are allowed on the new surface. No track shoes, street shoes, basketball, football, soccer shoes or cleated shoes of any kind are allowed on the track. If a child is wearing the wrong shoes he/she will be out of the track meet for the rest of the day.

At the March meeting the nominating committee will develop a slate of officers for next year. Please come to the March meeting with suggestions for new officers.

We need a volleyball assistant commissioner by the next meeting.

There was some discussion about having a commercial sponsorship for the C.K. Glover tournament. Joe Jekel will fill us in on the details.
