**3. Soccer**

Soccer will be played at the Ione Branch of the YMCA again this year.

All information has been posted on the CGSAA.org website.

All teams, exception dates and number of kids wanting to play, but without a team, are due at the next CGSAA meeting, September 2. The final team count must be turned in on Saturday, September 6 by noon. Games will start on the weekend of September 12 and will end before the first weekend in November.

Team costs will be \$200 for 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup>, \$150 for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>, and \$65 for a kindergarten team.

Soccer fees will be due at the October meeting.

#### 4. Volleyball

**A mandatory volleyball coaches meeting will be held at Christ the King on Monday, August 31, at 8:00 pm. Please encourage all your coaches to attend.**

Volleyball games will begin on the weekend of September 12 & 13 and continue until the end of October. The 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade league games will continue through October 24 and 25. The Bishop McGuinness Shamrock Tournament for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders will be on October 24 and 25. Only the top four teams from this tournament will qualify for the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade State Tournament on October 31 in Tulsa.

There will be a St. Elizabeth's 8<sup>th</sup> grade pre-season tournament on August 22 and a 7<sup>th</sup> grade pre-season tournament on August 29. There is a Monte Cassino Tournament for 8<sup>th</sup> graders on Sept. 19 and one for 7<sup>th</sup> graders on Sept. 26. Please let Matt know if your team plans to attend the tournaments at Monte Cassino so that he will not schedule a game for you in Oklahoma City on that date.

A copy of the rules and an information sheet were handed out at the meeting. One change is that a game may be lost on a serve. This year the game will be played as it is normally played. The serving line for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> will continue to be six feet inside court. Seventh graders may serve from this line if they are attempting an overhand serve. These rules will apply to any girl playing at that grade level. A sixth grader playing on a seventh grade team will follow the serving rules for the seventh grade. The rules will also be posted on the CGSAA website.

If there are any boys' teams interested in playing volleyball, bring that information to the meeting as well. Boys' teams will play up one grade level.
